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We prefer transmission by e-mail. If you want to send the paper on disk, the preferred storage medium is a 3.5 inch disk in MS-DOS format or on CD-ROM. Please use a new and correctly formatted disk and label this with your name.

1.2 File Format

Please send your paper as PDF-file and preferentially as *Word for Windows*TM document. In order to assure a smooth and fast reviewing process and in order to avoid discrepancies in the printouts we use the PDF-Format for data exchange. Your paper can be published faster and in higher quality if you follow the guidelines below:

Please make sure that the PDF-files submitted are **not write-protected** and have the following properties (you can use the file <DER-Journal_PDF-Print-Settings.joboptions> and put it into your distiller's settings directory):

- all fonts embedded
- page size of 177 mm x 250 mm
- resolution 2400 dpi (for PDF-file)

Please configure your PDF-distiller (e.g. Acrobat Distiller) accordingly. Under *Word for Windows*TM this is usually possible by selecting ->File ->Print and after selecting the PDF-writer as the printer by clicking the button ->properties.

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The paper submitted should contain original unpublished work. The Editorial Office does not accept responsibility for damage or loss of papers submitted. Upon acceptance of an article, the author will be asked to give a non-exclusive copyright of the article to the publisher. Our aim is to provide a decision on publication of articles within one-month period of reception in our editorial office.

1.4 Title page

The first page should contain the title, the authors' full names, the affiliation, a complete address of the corresponding author (with e-mail), a short and informative abstract with about 1500 characters incl. blanks (which has to fit on the first page) and show also the relation to the Journal's topic (Distributed Energy Resources/Distributed Generation), and five to ten keywords in alphabetical order, suitable for indexing.

2 STYLE GUIDELINES

Papers will be printed in black-and-white only. Please do not use colour graphics. If you are not working with the Word Template please use the following style guidelines for your document¹:

page size: 177 mm x 250 mm
top margin: 30 mm, bottom margin: 20 mm,
left margin: 20 mm, right margin: 20 mm,
inner margin (or back margin): 7 mm

Please leave the header empty and do not number the pages.

2.1 Standard Text (standard)

standard text: Times New Roman 11 pt. The text should be justified.

3 1ST HEAD

first-level headings: Times New Roman bold 11 pt, one line of space above, capitals.

3.1 2nd head

second-level headings: Times New Roman bold 11 pt, one line of space above.

3.1.1 3rd head

third-level headings and forth-level headings : Times New Roman bold 11pt, italic

3.1.1.1 4th head

forth-level headings, if necessary: Times New Roman 11pt, italic

Please insert listings as follows:

¹ Footnotes should be kept to a minimum and numbered consecutively throughout the text with Arabic numerals. Font: Times New Roman 9pt. Footnotes are impossible on the first page.

5 EXAMPLE FOR FIGURES

Please send your figures both embedded in your word file and in the original format (not embedded).

For printing a vector format is preferred. In case of photos etc. a resolution of 300 dpi should be provided. Please make sure that all text in the figures is readable (font size ≥ 8 pt).

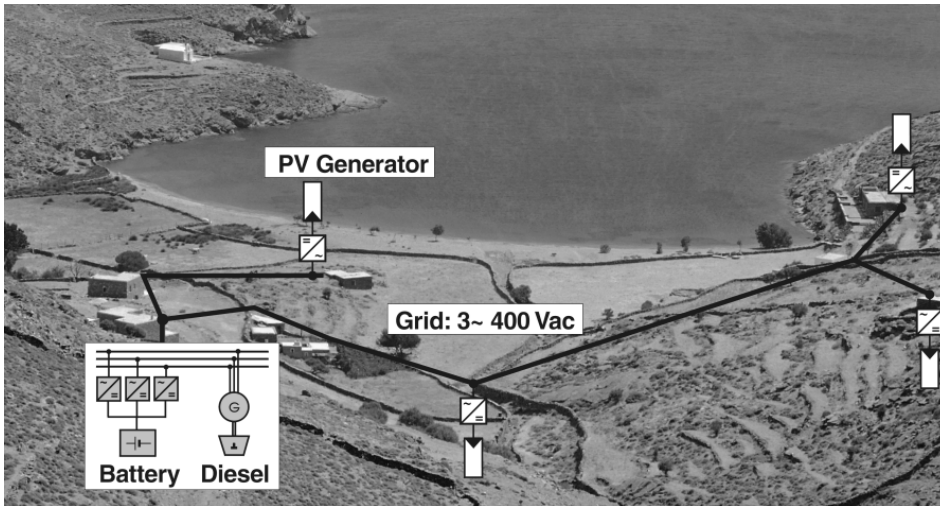


Figure 6.1: *Title of figure (figures should be centred and not be wider than 125 mm). Please do not forget to assure your copyright for the publication of figures.*

7 EXAMPLE FOR FORMULAE

Formulae should be centred.

$$P_{Total,Load} = \sum_{i=1}^n P_{Load_i} \quad (1)$$

and by:

$$P_{Total,Gen} = \sum_{j=1}^m P_{Gen_j} \quad (2)$$

Formulae should be numbered consecutively throughout the manuscript as (1), (2). In cases where the derivation of formulae has been abbreviated, it is of great help to the reviewers if the full derivation can be presented on a separate sheet (not to be published). Metric units according to the System of International Units (SI) should be used.
